

Miracle League of CT Everybody Dance Now COVID-19 Guidelines

The COVID-19 pandemic has impacted all our lives. We want so badly for things to return to “normal”. While we are not quite there yet, we want to be able to take some small steps towards that goal. We will be offering our Everybody Dance Now program to our players in a modified way so that we can remain as safe and healthy as possible. We will be establishing guidelines that are documented here. Of course, the decision to participate belongs to the parents. We fully understand that some of our dancers may be immuno-deficient. We trust that parents will consult with their physicians if that is the case. We will of course be prepared to adjust all plans in accordance with local, state, and federal guidance.

- Families are asked to arrive at the dance studio no more than 15 minutes before their scheduled class time.
- We ask that families follow social distancing protocols once they enter the studio, including in the parking lots and in all other areas of the property.
- All adults must wear a face covering when on the property.
- Admission to the studio will be limited to dancers and their immediate family members. We ask that you do not invite any spectators for whom it is not necessary to be there.
- Families are asked to leave the studio immediately following their class.
- Anyone who is having any of the following symptoms should not enter the studio:
 - Active COVID-19 infection
 - Fever
 - Unexplained Cough
- If you or anyone in your family has been in contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with (or is suspected to have) COVID-19 we ask that you don't come to the class for a minimum of 14 days since your last contact with that person(s).
- There will be 2 classes per week.
 - Class 1 will begin at 10am for dancers ages 4-11.
 - Class 2 will begin at 11:00am for dancers ages 12 and up.
 - Classes will last 45 minutes
 - Age groupings are subject to change depending on registration
- Classes will be limited to a total of 20 dancers per class
- All adults and dancer helpers (regardless of age) must wear a face covering while on or near Ballet Theatre Company property.
- All Teachers and volunteers must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 in order to participate.
- Dancers are not required to wear face coverings although, if they can, we encourage them to.
- A dancer showcase will be held at the end of the program at the Ballet Theatre Company performance space.
