The \$2500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from an accredited high school in the Greater Hartford area (please see attached map) who has shown commitment to their community through **volunteer service to children or adults with physical, cognitive or developmental challenges.** The scholarship is given in honor of the Ladd and Moran families who exemplify commitment to the special needs community through their service and support in the face of the tragic loss of their sons, Peter and Johnny, both at far too young an age.

Peter Ladd was born in 2001 with cerebral palsy. Although his condition prevented him from ever learning to talk, walk, or eat, he was able to enjoy horseback riding and playing Miracle League baseball thanks to the kindness of so many wonderful volunteers. He attended Norfeldt Elementary School in West Hartford where he was warmly accepted by the school community. Peter was fortunate to be loved and cared for by a very large and extended family. Peter passed away in 2012 at the age of 11.

Johnny Moran was born in 2007 with Wieacker Wolff Syndrome. He lived with many limitations from birth, but his spirit of strength and love rose far above. His positive attitude toward life affected all who came to know him. Johnny loved his family, his friends at

Norfeldt Elementary School, and his teammates and helpers on The Miracle League field. Johnny's dimpled smile will live on in the many hearts he touched in his short life. Johnny passed away at the age of 9 from complications of the syndrome in April of 2016.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Requirements and Prerequisites

- Must be a graduating student in good standing from an accredited Connecticut High School
- Must be accepted or enrolled at a 2 or 4 year accredited college and plan to be enrolled full time in the fall semester of 2022
- Immediate and extended family members of the Miracle League of CT Board of Directors, Advisory Board, or the Ladd and Moran families are not eligible to apply

Scholarship Considerations

- Commitment to the community through volunteer service for children & adults with special needs which may or may not include service to The Miracle League of CT – 50%
- Essay question response 40%
- Letter of recommendation 5%
- Academic achievement 5%

Required Materials for Application

- Completed scholarship application (incomplete applications will not be considered)
- A student resume no more than 2 pages in length which includes your volunteer service (single sided)
- Official sealed high school transcript
- One letter of recommendation from a supervisor, leader, or Executive Director of an organization or group that you volunteer for in a **sealed envelope**
- Write an essay (no more than 300 words) in response to the prompt question provided on the application
- Please do not submit any other materials other than those requested, they will not be considered in the evaluation process

Review and Evaluation Process

- All applications must be postmarked by April 16, 2022
- Applications will be evaluated by a 5 member committee
- Each committee member will score the 4 categories and the administrator will tally and compile the total scores
- The scholarship recipient will be notified in mid to late May
- The winner will be invited to be our guest along with his or her parents or guardians for a scholarship presentation ceremony at a Miracle League event.
